

# Belleville Quest Social Media Policy

Quest Team Member: Any individual over 18 participating or having participated on a Quest weekend at any point or serving on the Quest Board.

Belleville Quest sets forth the following guidelines for social media:

1. Quest Team Members may accept “friend” requests from Questers and other Quest Team Members at their own discretion. However, they may not initiate or send “friend” requests to Questers unless there is a pre-existing, non-Quest relationship (such as a family member or personal friend).
2. Quest Team Members are solely responsible for their own behavior, content and photos on social media. However, please keep in mind that by nature of your relationship beginning on a Quest, the Quester may perceive you as a role model or representative of the Belleville Quest program or Catholic faith. Please consider this when deciding whether to accept a request and how to conduct yourself on social media.
3. Quest Team Members that posts content or photos on social media that directly reference Belleville Quest in an inappropriate manner, as determined by the Belleville Quest Board or that retreat’s Director(s) or O.A.T.S. Director(s), may be requested to delete or remove any such pictures or content. Failure to comply may result in immediate or temporary suspension of Quest Team Member’s participation in Belleville Quest retreats or activities as determined by the Belleville Quest Board.
